## Event Descriptions

**Climbing Through Windows** - Learn how to cut, copy and paste text, and save, copy and delete a file in Windows. Participants are required to know how to use a mouse prior to the class.

**Web Workshop I** - Learn basic Web terms and simple searching skills. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Windows environment.

**Web Workshop II** - Learn advanced techniques for searching the Web and evaluating websites. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse, navigate comfortably in a Windows environment, and have basic Web skills.

**Microsoft Excel** - Learn to set up a simple spreadsheet to track household expenses. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Windows environment.

**Microsoft Word** - Learn how to create a document in this word processing software. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Windows environment.

**Web-based Email** - Learn the parts of a Web-based email, email etiquette and where you can obtain a free email account. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Web environment.






**Researching Your Family Tree** - Learn methods for researching your family tree online including the use of free websites as well as library databases like *HeritageQuest* and *Ancestry Library Edition*. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Web environment.

**Downloadable Books** - Learn how to download and listen to free audio books available through the Bucks County Library Network. The topics covered include: the downloading and installation of the free *OverDrive* software; browsing, selecting and downloading titles, and transfer of the titles to a portable device (PDA, MP3 player, cell phone, etc) or burn to CD, when available. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Web environment.
