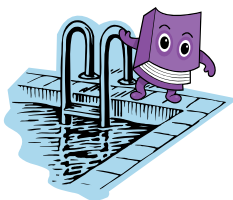

Computer Technology Classes

Advance registration is required; call 215-788-7891 ext. 6 to register.

Computer Basics - Learn the parts of a home PC, scrolling, mouse clicking and resizing Windows.

Climbing Through Windows - Learn how to cut, copy and paste text, and save, copy and delete a file in Windows. Participants are required to know how to use a mouse prior to the class.

Internet for Beginners - Learn basic web terms, how to use search engines and how to evaluate web pages. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Windows environment.

Microsoft Word I: Basics - Learn how to create, format text, save, open and print a document. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Windows environment.

Microsoft Word II: Beyond the Basics - Learn how to create a document with a template, insert pictures, and how to create a table.

Microsoft Excel I: Basics - Learn to set up a simple spreadsheet to track household expenses. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Windows environment.

Microsoft Excel II: Beyond the Basics - Learn how to freeze rows

and columns, how to create formulas from cell references, and create basic charts from data. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Windows environment.

Researching Your Family Tree - Learn methods for researching your family tree online including the use of free websites as well as library databases like *HeritageQuest* and *Ancestry Library Edition*. Prerequisite: Patron must be able to use a mouse and navigate comfortably in a Web environment.

Introduction to *Foundation Directory Online* - Is your nonprofit organization looking for funds? Come to the Grundy Library and learn how to use the *Foundation Directory Online*, the premier grant seeking database.
